JR East to be requested to withdraw dismissal and reinstate 1,047 Japan National Railways (JNR) workers,

according to the decision of the Supreme Court

On June 30, 2015, regarding to the case of non-re-employment of some union members of National Railway Motive Power Union of Chiba (Doro-Chiba), the Supreme Court upheld and finalized the following Tokyo High Court ruling;

"It is duly acknowledged that the Japanese National Railways (JNR) did not write down the names of Doro-Chiba members on the list of candidates to be rehired by the East Japan Railway Company (JR East), having a purpose and motive to discriminate and unfairly treat the members of unions opposing the division and privatization of JNR (*intension of unfair labor practice*), and plotting out the criteria not to enroll on the list."

"The dismissed workers held the potential to be employed by the Japan Railways (JR) in an appreciable extent."

According to the decision of the Supreme Court affirming the unfair labor practice done by JNR, we demand for JR East to employ the dismissed workers."
